**POLISH PRESIDENT'S PLAIN CRASH** – Lech Kaczyński and his wife, Maria were killed as presidential aircraft crashes near fog-bound airport in Slomens, Russia, with no survivors on Saturday, April 10. At least 96 people died when the Tu-154 aircraft clipped trees on its approach to Smolensk airport. The crash wiped out almost half of Poland's leadership. Those killed included also the army chief of staff, the head of the national bank, Poland's deputy foreign minister, some members of parliament and senat, Catholic and Orthodox military bishops... Lech Kaczyński had been flying to Slemensk to attend the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Katyń massacre, where Soviet secret police executed 22,000 Polish officers in the one of the most notorious incidents of the WWII. Poland has suffered its worst political disaster! Kaczyński is the first serving Polish leader to die since exiled second world war-era leader General Władysław Sikorski perished in a plane crash off Gibraltar in 1943. The Holy Mass for all this tragedy victims Fr. Robert celebrated last Monday in Frackville, at 6:00PM - 7 **people** attended.

**Receiving the Holy Eucharist** – those who believe in the true presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist are invited to partake of this Holy Sacrament. It is the practice of the PNCC to distribute the Holy Eucharist through the method of intinction. The Body and Blood of Christ is placed on the tongue, not in the hand.
