**Receiving the Holy Eucharist** – those who believe in the true presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist are invited to partake of this Holy Sacrament. It is the practice of the PNCC to distribute the Holy Eucharist through the method of intinction. The Body and Blood of Christ is placed on the tongue, not in the hand.

**HOW DOES YOUR CHURCH SCORE?** A reporter visited different churches on successive Sunday's to find out what the churches were really like. In every instance, he dressed neatly and stood near the front. After services, he walked slowly to the near, then returned to the front, and went back to the foyer using another aisle. He smiled at everyone and asked others for directions to specific places – the parish hall, the office, etc. He reminded for coffee, if served. Using the following scale, he awarded points on the following basis:

- 10 for a smile from a worshipper
- 10 for a greeting from someone nearby
- 100 for an exchange of names
- 200 for an invitation to have coffee
- 200 for an invitation to return
- 1,000 for an invitation to meet another worshipper

2,000 for an invitation to meet the pastor.

The reporter discovered that, using this scale, 11 of the 18 churches visited earned *fewer than 100 points*. Five actually received *less than 20!* The conclusion: The doctrine may be sound, the singing inspirational, and the sermon uplifting – but when a visitor finds nobody who cares whether he's there, he is not likely to return!

**CONFESSIONS FOR THE YOUTH** – Our younger members as well as their parents are reminded that Confession is an essential part of a child's religious upbringing. Remember this important part of their religious life. Confession is held on the **first Sunday** of every month at **10:45AM** (before Mass). If children (until Confirmation) would like to receive the Holy Communion in a worthy manner they must come for private confession at least once a month. When other times are necessary please contact Fr. Robert.

**MEMBERS DUES 2010.** Since January 2005, a change was made that eliminated the 'family plan' method for paying Church dues. This change was voted upon and approved at the last General Synod.

Each adult member will now be recorded as an individual unit. This means every adult member is now responsible for his/her own dues. To continue to be a member at the Holy Ghost Parish and a member of the Polish National Catholic Church each adult will be responsible for paying the following:

# Total dues for 2010 per Adult Member: <u>\$95.00 Per Year</u>

The parish itself has an obligation to pay dues according to the number of active members to the General Church and Diocese and our financial administration distributes these monies also as directed by the General Synod. A breakdown of where these dollars are sent is available upon request.

There are also many other funds within your parish that require your attention and need your donations:

Sunday Collection, Fuel Fund, Cemetery Fund, Clergy/Pension Fund, Easter Donations, Bleenie Sales (we had a great time last year, come out help out, join in the fun...), Chinese Auction, and Christmas Donations.
